We are pleased to invite submissions for the briq Climate Workshop, to be held in person in Bonn on November 17-18, 2022.

The workshop will feature innovative papers at the intersection of climate change and the behavioral sciences. Contributions from neighboring fields such as political science or philosophy are also welcome.

Topics include (but are not limited to):

- The behavioral foundations of climate-relevant behavior, such as the role of preferences, values, or social norms
- Mechanisms and policy interventions to promote behavioral change
- The public acceptance of climate policies
- The behavioral consequences of climate change

Submission

Please use the [Online Application Form](#) to submit pdf versions of papers (preferred) or extended abstracts. The deadline for paper submission is August 31, 2022 (23.59 CEST). Confirmations will be sent by September 9, 2022. About 15 participants will be invited.

Kindly note that we expect the submitter to be the presenter of the paper. Participants are expected to stay for the entire workshop.

Funding

The workshop will be hosted and fully financed by briq. Second-class train travel, economy class airfares, and three nights of lodging including breakfast and meals included in the program will be covered for invitees according to the briq reimbursement guidelines.
